

Private Sector In Lebanon

- Lebanon was historically a center for finance, commerce, and tourism.
- The private sector greatly contributed to the country's growth and recovery after the repeated wars.
- Despite the political turmoil and the economic crisis, the private sector stabilized the economy and protected Lebanon from falling into a recession.
- One of the few sectors that withstood crisis over the years is the solid banking sector

Private sector coalition

Regional Humanitarian Demining School of Lebanon

- Established in Hamana with the support of the EU and French government
- Expansion to be funded by a private sector company CEO

School capacities

The school is equipped and can accommodate 20 students:

- 2 classrooms.
- 2 training fields.
- 10 single rooms
- 16 double rooms.

The private sector will contribute to furnishing the second half of the school enabling it to accommodate 40 Students

- 5 single rooms
- 8 double rooms.

the collaboration takes on a new environmental mission which is planting trees in all demined areas of Lebanon.


LMAC and BLOM BANK organized an event in one of the demined lands in Houla (South of Lebanon) to announce the results, and planted 400 olive trees in the land.
